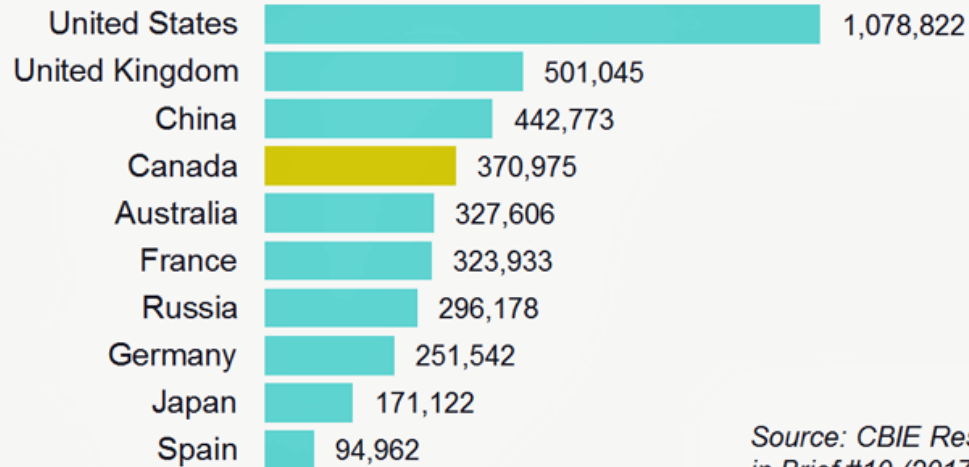

International Education in Canada

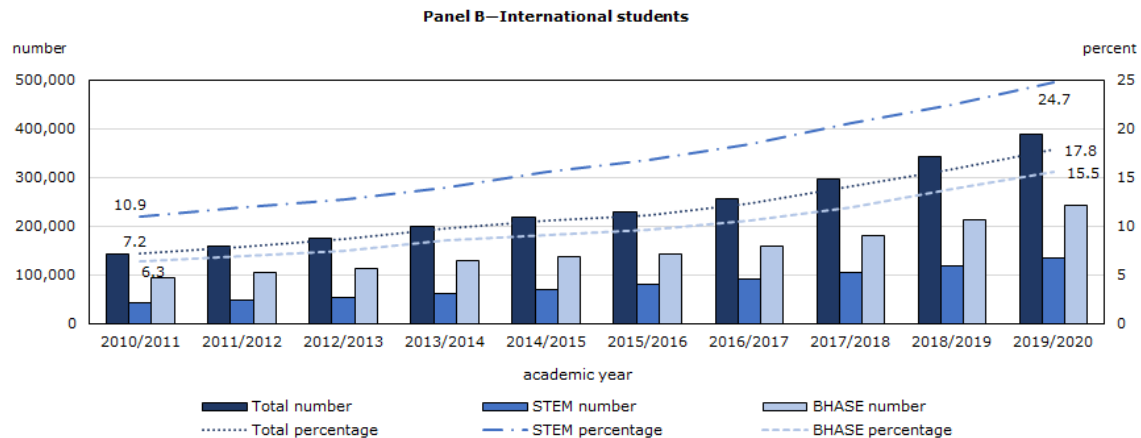
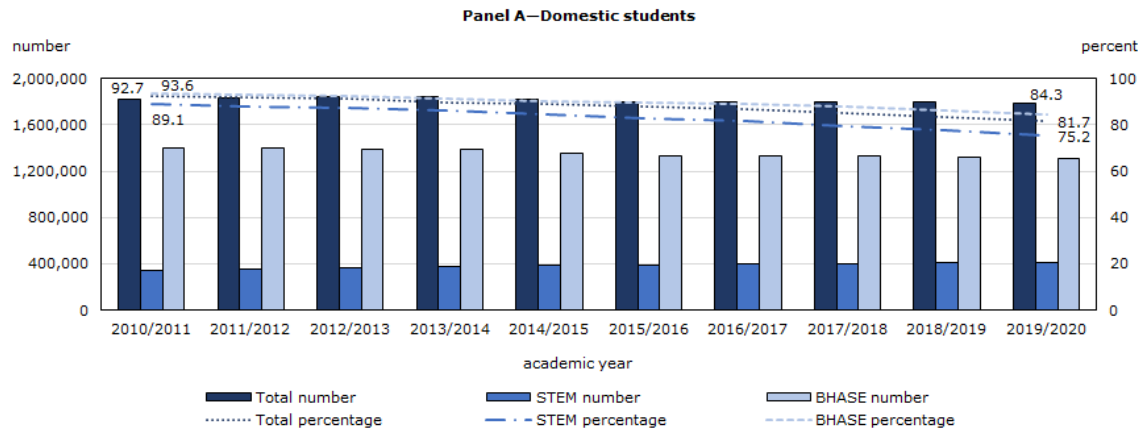

Top 10 Host Countries for International Students (2017)

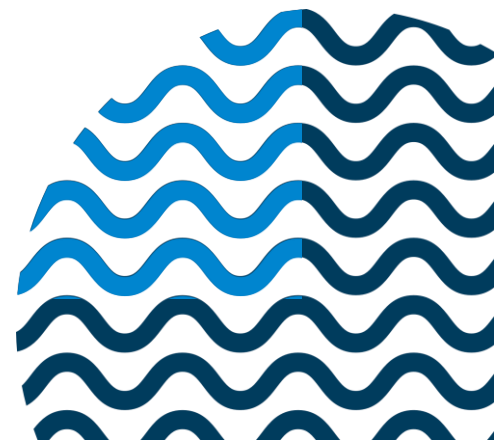
